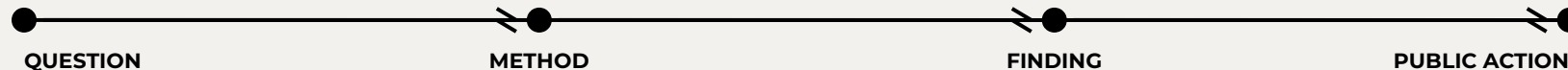

Use a neutral frame for an image, diagram or artefact. Keep the source rail in the same place.

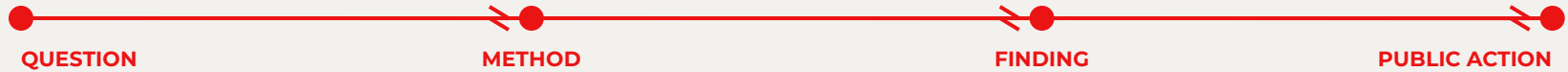

SHOW THE METHOD.

A four-step rail makes process visible without turning the slide into a workflow diagram.

01

ASK

Define the question.

02

TEST

Choose the method.

03

REVIEW

Name the limit.

04

SHARE

Make the next step public.

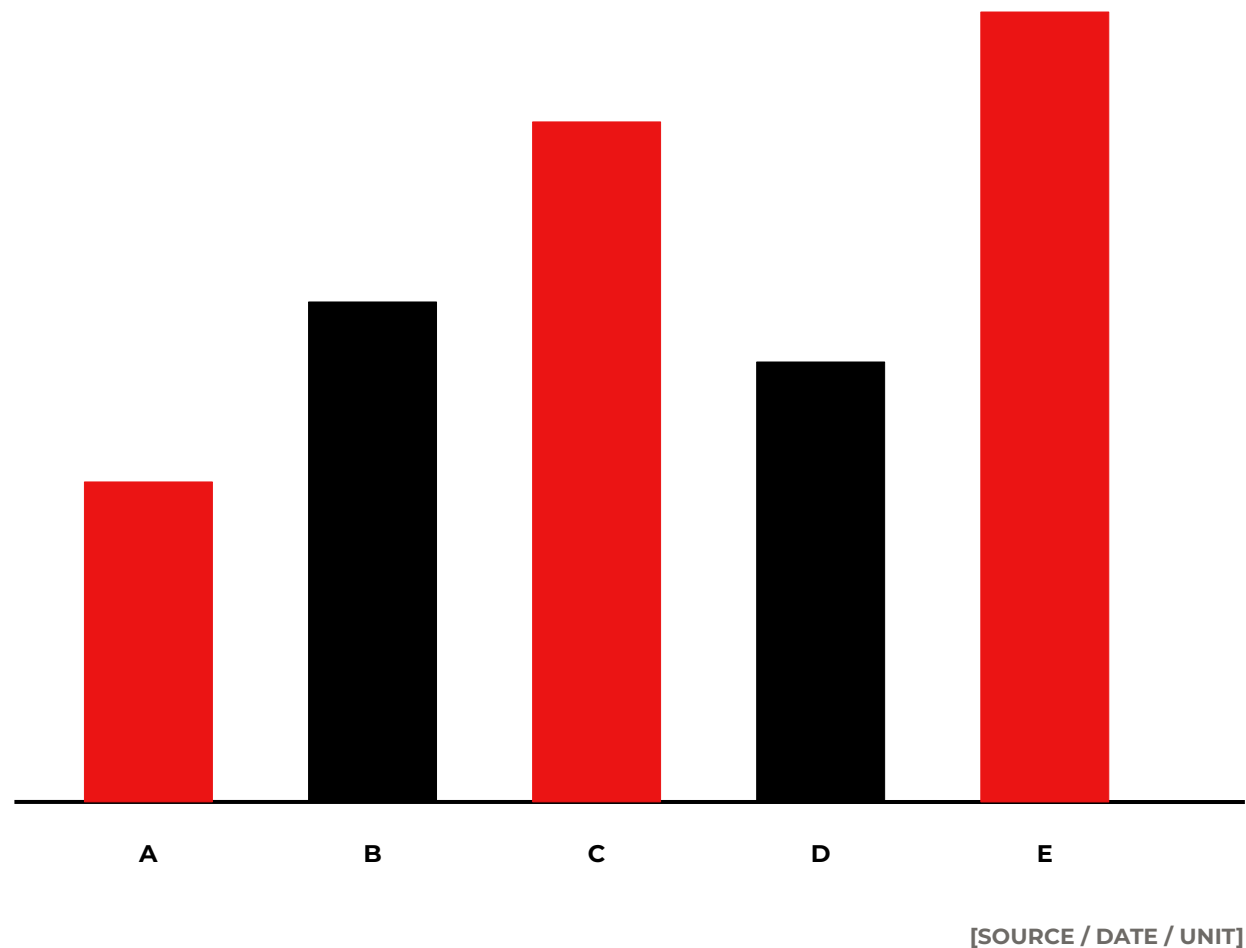
